Model stitched on 32 count Waterlily Linen from Wichelt. The stitch count is 99w x 103h. 2 ply of floss used for cross-stitching unless otherwise noted.

You will also need:

Kreinik #4 Braid 3514
Wisconsin Woods CCT-114

Backstitch Instructions:

Face, arms and legs with 1 ply of Wisconsin Woods, eyelash with 2 ply of Wisconsin Woods, wings with 1 strand of Kreinik #4 braid 3514.

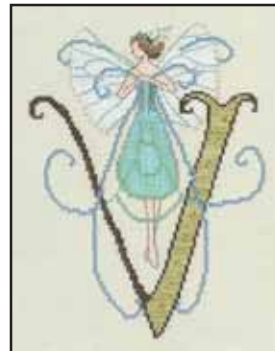
Attach beads with YLI invisible thread.

*Crescent Colours threads are hand dyed and sometimes the colors are not exact matches.
